We followed the hearing that took place on 3<sup>rd</sup> October with great interest and we particularly appreciated the fact that you reiterated the role and importance of the Advisory Councils during your replies to the questions put to you by the MEPs. The Advisory Councils are a platform that includes and represents both the professional fisheries sector (small-scale fisheries, the industrial fleet and the sector's trade unions) as well as other interest groups, such as environmental organisations and recreational fishers' associations.
