



## **SEAWise Regional Review Workshop**

Drawing on the expert input of the fishing industry, policy makers, fisheries managers, and advisory organisations, SEAWise is an international project working to assemble a new knowledge base – creating a comprehensive view of the current state of play of European fisheries, in support of practical operationalisation of ecosystem based fisheries management (EBFM).

Organised across four Case Study regions – the Mediterranean, Western Waters, North Sea and Baltic Sea, stakeholder collaboration is a key component of SEAWise. This collaboration helps to ensure that the knowledge gaps we address, and predictive management advice tools we develop, are truly useful and applicable across our Case Study regions, and on the wider European policy stage.

Now in our final year, and following earlier scoping, the SEAWise Regional Review Workshop will offer an opportunity to present and discuss the work we have done with stakeholders, and gather insights for incorporation in the final evaluations of the project, and future work. The workshop will also offer an opportunity to explore and provide feedback on the SEAWise EBFM Toolbox and Tool that have been developed as part of the project.
